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FCC/USAC News

- 1. FCC Commissioner Mignon Clyburn has announced that she will resign her post over the next few weeks.
- 2. FCC issued a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) on April 17, 2018 titled, "FCC Proposes Prohibiting Universal Service Spending on Equipment and Services from Companies that Pose National Security Threats" WC Docket No. 18-19.
- 3. USAC unveiled a new Funding Commitment Decision Letter (FCDL) format.

SC E-Rate Consortia Update

- 1. 2017-18 Current: E-Rate Funding Year (07/01/2017 06/30/2018)
 - a. Waves 48-51: No FCDL's
 - There is a total of 984 Funding Request Numbers (FRNs):
 - 874 FRNs have been funded, 6 FRNs are pending and 104 FRNs cancelled/denied.
 - Approximately \$18.4 million awarded to SC applicants, and approximately \$7.59 million has been invoiced as of 04/23/18.
 - School Internet is in review but have been escalated to USAC for intervention. School WAN is Wave ready.
- 2. <u>2018-19 Upcoming: E-Rate Funding Year (07/01/2018 06/30/2019)</u>
 - a. Waves 1-2: \$2,371,335.89 (83 pf 847 FRNs)
 - 49 applications for 39 entities
 - b. Upcoming SC E-Rate Consortium Training.
 - April 24th: Quarterly E-Rate Virtual Meeting had 25 attendees.
 - May 9th: Applicant Training Florence SC (make-up)
- 3. Cisco Umbrella Update
 - a. There is a total of 164 customers, two served as test sites, six already have Umbrella, and eight have declined Umbrella leaving 148 customers.
 - b. Of the 148 customers, 138 have responded to the technical assistance poll with nearly all complete. Of the remaining 10 customers, 3 are awaiting Internet service (Bettis Prep, High Point, East Link), 3 have been completely unresponsive (PALS, Bridgewater, Greer Middle), 2 have recently undergone staff turnover (Bamberg 1, Barnwell 29), and 1 is evaluating many technical challenges (FE Dubose).
 - c. Schools wishing to keep sensors may after they are returned, wiped clean and new asset tags issued.
