## SC E-Rate Consortia Update

- 1. <u>2016-17 Past: E-Rate Funding Year (07/01/2016 06/30/2017)</u>
  - a. No significant change on School and Special School Internet Application appeal.
  - b. USAC representative stated on a phone call that the appeal is nearing the end of its review and that an IT fix would be deployed in early March.
- 2. <u>2017-18 Current: E-Rate Funding Year (07/01/2017 06/30/2018)</u>
  - a. Waves 1-36: \$15,123,377.31
  - b. Waves 25-36: \$5,559,108.13 to 28 applicants in South Carolina.
  - c. PIA Outreach has begun on statewide applications as of September 25<sup>th</sup>.
    - There are a total of 984 Funding Request Numbers (FRNs): 858 FRNs have been funded, 27 FRNs are pending 99 FRNs cancelled/denied.
    - The State's Dark Fiber applications were funded this month.
    - School Internet and School WAN are still in initial review.
- 3. <u>2018-19 Upcoming: E-Rate Funding Year (07/01/2018 06/30/2019)</u>
  - a. Past SC E-Rate Consortium Training

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- 1. There are a total of 159 customers, two served as test sites, five already have Umbrella, and four have declined Umbrella leaving 147 customers.
- 2. Of the 147 customers, 105 have responded to the technical assistance poll and are at some station in our process.
- 3. Of the 105 customers in our process, 73 have completed the account activation and configuration.
- 4. Recovery of sensors has begun.

- 1. A copy of the 2017-18 General Appropriations Act (1A.84.) and a 2017-18 Funding Manual regarding (SDE-EIA: Aid to Districts-Technology) was provided at the meeting. These documents contains the criteria that is required in order to qualify for a funding waiver. Dept. of Education will be responsible for providing a copy of this to the school districts.
- 2. Aiken County Public Schools submitted a waiver requesting to expend K-12 funds to purchase and install classroom audio-visual equipment. The committee will send a letter to the district as well as a copy of the 2017-18 General Appropriations Act (1A.84.) and a 2017-18 Funding Manual asking for an updated request following the guidelines set forth in the funding manual.
- 3. York School District 1 submitted a waiver requesting to expend K-12 funds for Mobile Device Management and the replacement of old projector/interactive white boards. The committee needed some clarification and is requesting that the request be rewritten and resubmitted.
