Bandwidth Allocation



Revisions to Internet Policy

- Districts will be provided with a minimum funded 100 Mbps connection
- Eligible tier structure has been consolidated from 20 to 5 levels

***Bandwidth adjustments will be made based on the PowerSchool
*QDC1 45th day of school data provided by SCDE***

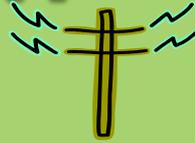
Bandwidth Allocation



Revisions to Private-Side WAN/LAN Policy

- Districts will be provided with a minimum funded 100 Mbps connection to individual schools.
- Eligible HUB/Host bandwidth speed will be determined based on feeder locations and not student counts.

Bandwidth Allocation



Impact of Policy Revisions

- Improved availability of broadband resources to support the evolving technology-rich public education infrastructure.
 - Online Curriculum Standards, Devices, Cloud Computing, 1 to 1
- Majority of monthly cost share assessments have been eliminated .
 - Direct cost saving to all state network members
- Significantly lower monthly cost share assessments imposed when acquiring additional bandwidth beyond eligible funded levels.
 - As a result of contract negotiations

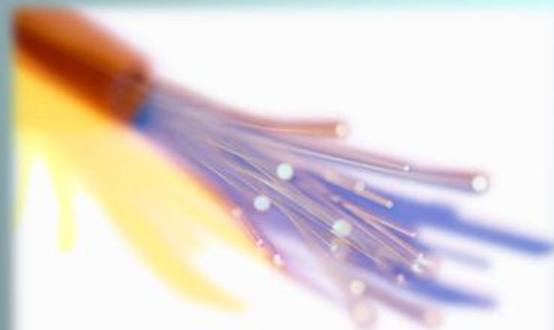

FY 2013-14 Program Changes & Updates



Eligible Services Listing (ESL)

- Consolidation of all Priority One services into one listing and three main sections
 - Modified FCC Form 470 and 471 documents anticipated
 - The correct service category must be selected on FCC Form 471
- Minor format changes



Competitive Bidding Compliance-FCC Form 470 and RFP Issues

- Effective FY 2013, FCC rules prohibit applicants from including a particular manufacturer's name, brand, product, or service in FCC Form 470 or RFP posting unless the words "or equivalent" are used.
- Impose Restrictions

FY 2013-14 Program Changes & Updates



Lowest Corresponding Price (LCP) Compliance

- FCC requirement that must be met by **all** providers of eligible services
- Rule ensures that service providers do not charge E-Rate participants more than they would charge their other customers for the same services.
- To ensure applicants receive competitive prices



Note: E-Rate filers are **not obligated** to ask for the LCP, but **must** receive it!
