My Big Campus

- **Free to Lightspeed customers (filtering, mobile device management and email archiving solution)**
- **Facebook like interface**
- **Monitored by “real” people**
- **Abuse can also be reported**
- **Email alerts can be sent**
- **Teachers can monitor students**



My Big Campus

- **Student classes can be imported via PowerSchool imports (in process of automating the process)**
- **Teachers can post calendars, announcements, assignments**
- **Approved videos from YouTube**
- **Content Bundles developed by teachers and professionals**
- **Collaborative discussions with students and teachers**
- **Variety of online quizzes (Teachers can export and import into PowerTeacher)**



My Big Campus

- **Can import from ExamView (many teachers receive with their textbooks)**
- **Post and share documents**
- **Unlimited storage for teachers and students**



Destiny Library

- **Students can invite friends and discuss books**
- **Students can post reviews of books**
- **Recommend titles to their friends**
- **Can send messages**
- **Safe environment**



Office 365

- **Office in the cloud (familiar tools that students already are using and most commonly used in the business world)**
- **Can be integrated into our current Active Directory Structure (will be using ANC Group from Greenville for this)**
- **Documents can be integrated so that student documents go onto our in-house servers**
- **Variety of pricing but basic service is free**
- **Will save money on licenses**

Facebook, MySpace and Twitter

- **No access to Facebook, Twitter except for district office staff, school principals and resource officers**
- **Social media policies in place**
- **No communication with students except through district approved communication tools**
- **No personal email accounts or student personal email accounts for correspondence**
- **No texting**
- **Encouraged to block students from online personal networking profiles or webpages**
- **Personal Social Networking addressed in the AUP Policy**



Other Districts

- **No access to any of these sites**
- **Facebook for teachers only**
- **Facebook school and district pages (some have guidelines some do not)**
- **MySpace open and blocked**
- **Twitter open and blocked**

Internet Safety

- **Use State Internet Safety Standards and require that all teachers incorporate into their online lesson plans for documentation**
- **Require documentation from schools at the end of each school year for Erate**
- **Provide webpages on the district website for teachers and students on Internet Safety**
- **Had hoped to incorporate into Tech Assessment but have just been informed it is being discontinued**

What Can You Do?

- **Provide more guidance and training material**
- **Online curriculum that shows that all students in SC K-12 schools have completed that also incorporates tech skill testing that indicates readiness for Common Core testing**



CIPA

- **Lightspeed filtering**
- **Various levels of filtering for different groups**
 - Young students (grades PK – 6)
 - Older students (grades 7 – 12)
 - Faculty and Staff
 - Internet Safety Group
- **Can complete an online form that comes directly to me which is addressed immediately**

What Can You Do?


- **Help get costs down for filtering**
